

## Masks



- Masks are required per the Centers for Disease Control, Illinois Department of Public Health, and the Illinois State Board of Education.
- Students cannot board a bus or enter the school building unless they have a DOCTOR'S NOTE stating a specific medical condition as to why they cannot medically wear one.
  - With a doctor's note, students may attend class with accommodations.
- Masks should be worn appropriately with the chin, mouth, and nose covered.
- Masks must follow the dress code laid out in the school handbook.

# How are we going to sanitize between classes?



- In the last 2 minutes of each class period, students will thoroughly sanitize their desks and chairs. The teacher will disinfect the door knob, and any commonly touched surfaces.
- The rooms will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected at the end of each day by maintenance staff.

### What if your child gets sick at school?



- If your child gets sick at school and exhibits any of the symptoms of Covid-19, they will be sent to a quarantine room until the student can be picked up.
- They will then need to be tested for Covid-19 or be quarantined for 14 days, during which they can participate in Remote Learning.
- Students will need documentation (from health dept) of their release from quarantine date to return to school.

There are NO perfect attendance awards this year. Please do NOT send your child to school sick.



## Restrooms



- Hands-free systems are being installed for toilets, soap dispensers, sinks, and paper towel dispensers.
- Students will be allowed to go to the restroom at certain "Bathroom Break" times.
  - This is to limit the number of people in any one restroom at one time.
- New fountains have been installed with refilling stations. Regular water fountains cannot be used, but these refilling stations can. Cups will be provided for drink breaks.

Hand Sanitizer will be available on stands throughout the building.

## What are we doing to keep your child safe in the classroom?

- Masks will be worn in the classrooms.
- Social distancing will be maintained to the greatest extent possible.
- Faculty and Staff will be required to perform the same symptom and temperature checks as required of students.
- Per state guidelines, all desks will be socially distanced to the greatest extent possible.
- Mask breaks will be given during the day.
- All classrooms and common areas will be disinfected each day.





## Meals



- Breakfast will be served in their assigned classroom/homeroom.
- Lunch will be served in the commons area/cafeteria. Social distancing rules will be observed. Number of students per table will be limited.

## **School Arrival Procedures**

#### Car Drop-off

- When dropping off your child, you will pull up to the main entrance and remain in your car.
- Student drop-off begins at 7:45 AM- students will remain in the commons at designated areas until 8:00 AM
- Please do not send students to school with a fever or other COVID symptoms

#### **Bus Riders**

- Masks must be worn on the school bus.
- Please do not put students on the bus with a fever or other COVID symptoms.



## **School Dismissal Procedures**

#### Car Pick-up

- When picking up your child, you will line up in the bus parking lot.
- You will proceed around the school one car at a time under the direction of school staff. When it is your turn, a school representative will arrange for your student(s) to meet you at the car.
- This will occur across from the outside gym.
- This will begin at 2:45 P.M.

#### **Bus Riders**

 Students MUST wear their masks while on the bus.




## Lockers




- We will be using lockers this year until health guidelines suggest otherwise.
- Only CLEAR backpacks are allowed.
- Students will only have designated times to go to their lockers each day.
  - In Jr. High, they only have a math book. Everything else is online.
  - In High School, there are online textbooks for health, social studies, some science classes, and family and consumer science classes.

# Phones



- Students should power down their phones and leave them in their lockers from 8:00 to 2:42.
- If teachers see them or hear them, then the school's handbook policy will be enforced.

## Dress Code



- Dress code will be strictly enforced this year according to the handbook.

## Remote Learning
